

PRESS RELEASE**MPH Industries announces the sale of 449 BEE III radar units for use by the Romanian National Police Force.**

John Broxon, MPH's International Sales Manager, announced today the delivery of 449 of its BEE III traffic radars to the *Poliția Română*, the Romanian National Police Force, as part of the Radar Autovision system produced by Traffic Safety Systems, Ltd. The Traffic Directorate of the *Poliția* will be using these radar systems to maintain safe roadway speeds in Romania.

Mr. Broxon explained that this is not the first time that MPH has sold radars for use by the *Poliția*. In 2002, the *Poliția* purchased 250 of our Python radars as part of an earlier version of the Radar Autovision system. He added that MPH is of the contribution that our radar systems have made to the safety of the Romanian roadways for the last eight years, which will continue through the use of the BEE III radars.

The sale of BEE III radars for use by the *Poliția* follows closely after purchases by the Turkish police forces (*Emniyet* and *Gendarmerie*) and Bulgarian Traffic Police. For Romania, MPH supplied a new version of the BEE III radar which fully conforms to all European specifications, so it can be used throughout the European Union. MPH believes that the BEE III KCE is the only moving traffic radar that fully conforms to the European R&TTE specifications.
