

PRESS RELEASE**MPH Industries announces the sale of 435 BEE III radar units to the Turkish General Directorate of Security.**

John Broxon, MPH's International Sales Manager, announced today the sale of 435 of its BEE III traffic radars to the General Directorate of Security in Turkey. Better known as the Turkish National Police or Emniyet, their focus is municipal law enforcement, including traffic enforcement in those areas.

“Earlier this year, the Turkish Gendarmerie also chose the BEE III radar to fulfill its speed enforcement needs”, he also stated. “The principal duty of the Gendarmerie (Jandarma), a branch of the Turkish Armed Forces, is law enforcement outside of the areas enforced by the National Police, generally in rural areas of the country.”

Mr. Broxon explained that this is not the first time that MPH has sold radars to the Turkish police forces. “The police in Turkey have been using MPH radar equipment for quite some time now. This relationship began with the purchase of Python Series I radars for the Turkish Gendarmerie in 1997. MPH is proud that both Turkish police forces, the National Police and the Gendarmerie, have both chosen the BEE III to meet their speed enforcement needs.”
